

## Evaluating sources in SBQ

### REQUIREMENTS

1. Understanding demands of the question, unpacking the meaning of the thesis statement given
2. Group sources according to the question normally agree/disagree
3. Analyse sources, making inferences with regards to the question, writing down what the source has to say about a particular topic/issue
  - a. Must read in between the lines
  - b. Must immediately support with evidence from the source, **including PROVENANCE** (e.g. origin of source, DATE, person, etc.)
4. Verify evidence, cross-refer with other sources including CK - READINGS, BOOKS, DOCUMENTARIES

DO 1-4 RELIGIOUSLY FOR ALL THE SOURCES, YOU WILL GET A 4.0 (as much as 18 marks!!!)

5. \*\*\*\*\* EVALUATE SOURCES w.r.t. QUESTION/STATEMENT [CONCLUSION]

If you find that all the sources you agree, reliable; all those that don't agree, unreliable, explain how source limitations/reliability issues **AFFECT DISCUSSION OF THE QUESTION/STATEMENT → RECONCILE THE DIFFERENCES**
